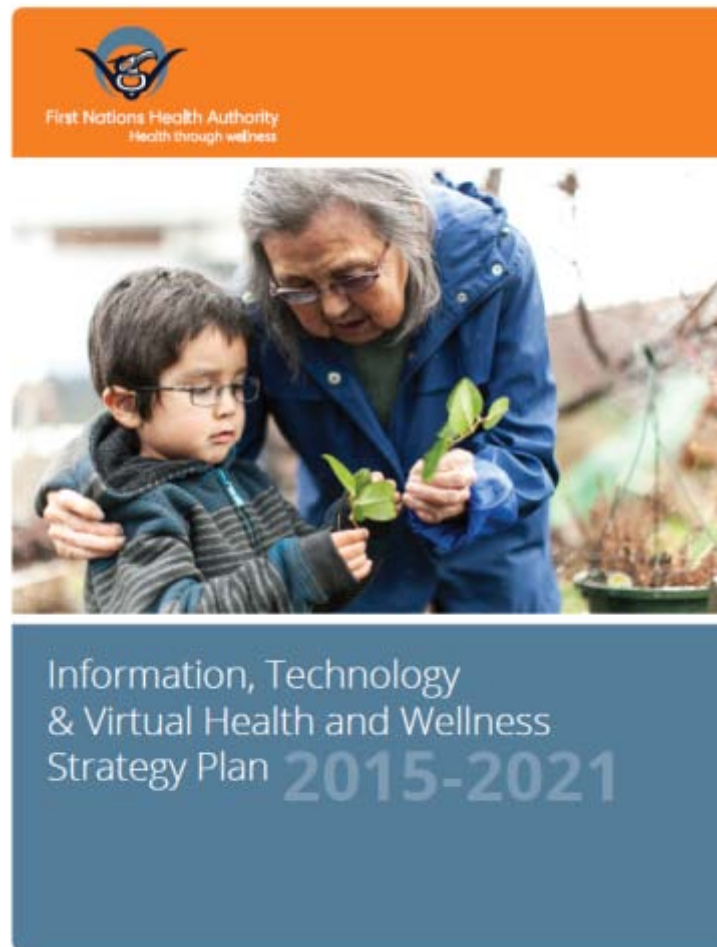
7 Directives

eHealth Strategy Objectives

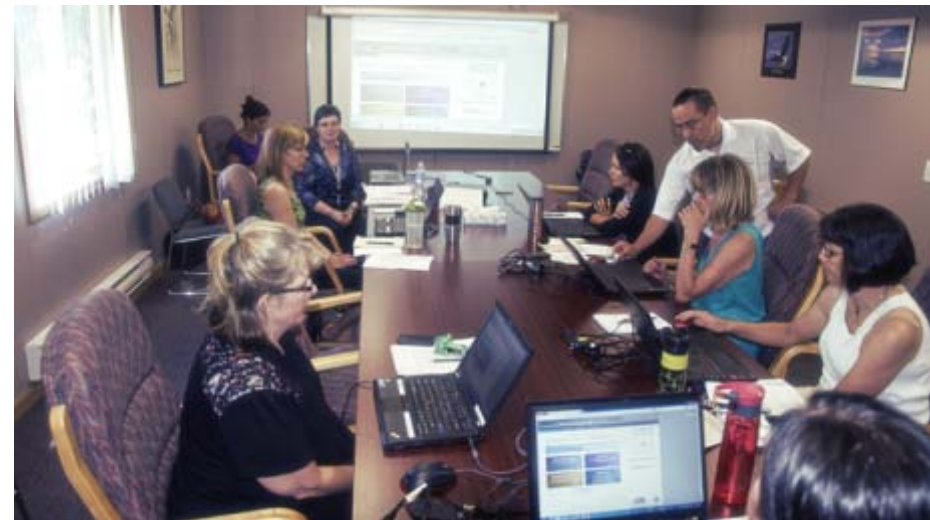
