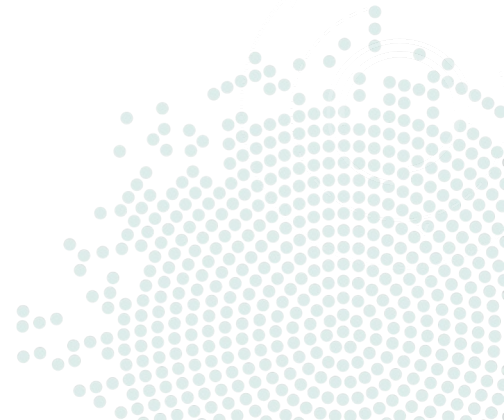

# e-Health is a vital centre of Canadian digital health discussion and debate

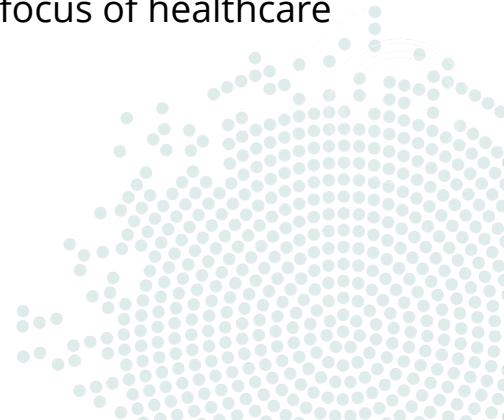
- Held annually in Toronto or Vancouver since 2000
- Up to 1,500 attendees (in person)
- Held virtually in 2020, 2021, 2022
- Back to in-person in Toronto for May 28 - 30, 2023, with 1,300 in attendance
- Heading to Vancouver for May 26 - 28, 2024





## What are we looking for in a presentation?

We are looking for submissions that describe **initiatives, technologies, processes, or delivery models** that have the potential to change the face and focus of healthcare delivery in Canada.







We want to hear stories from across **all care settings**: acute care, community care, home care, long term care, First Nations health, BIPOC communities, mental health, and telehealth/virtual health.





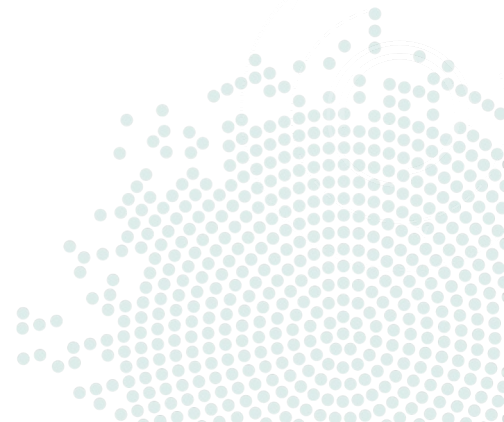

# Presentation types

Panel	Duration: 30 minutes (includes 5-10 minutes Q&A) 3 presenters
Oral	Duration: 15 minutes with optional Q&A 1 or 2 presenters
Rapid Fire	Duration: 7 minutes (3 slides x 2 minutes per slide) 1. The healthcare challenge 2. The existing barriers 3. The solutions Moderated, with Q&A after the last presentation of the session (if time permits) 1 presenter, with multiple presentations per session
e-Poster	Duration: 5 minutes (Q&A if time permits) Defined electronic visual format with all data on one slide 1 presenter





## Helpful tips

Talk about projects that offer new, innovative, and relevant discussion of ideas, methods, technologies or techniques. Your project should offer a different perspective by virtue of setting, discipline, or approach.





Show us a successful implementation of an e-health or digital health solution.

If some part of it was unsuccessful, contribute new knowledge or lessons learned.

Address a topic of importance.





Share your experience, findings, and results.

Clearly describe the experience and expected outcome (or a new initiative with an approved strategic plan and budget)

Include a recommendation for next steps.

Demonstrate concrete outcomes of an initiative completed or in progress.
