- Up to 1,500 attendees (in person)
- Held virtually in 2020, 2021, 2022
- In-person in Toronto in 2023 with 1,300 in attendance, and in Vancouver for May 26 – 28, 2024, with 1,200 in attendance – SOLD OUT!
- Heading back to Toronto, June 1 – 3, 2025



We are looking for submissions that describe **initiatives**, **technologies**, **processes**, or **delivery models** that have the potential to change the face and focus of healthcare delivery in Canada.

Presentation types

e-Poster	Duration: 10 minutes, Q&A if time permits Presenters: 1 (one) Format: defined electronic visual with all data on one slide
Oral	Duration: 20 minutes, includes optional Q&A Presenters: 1 or 2 (max 2) Format: multiple slides (optional)
Panel	Duration: 30 minutes, includes 5 – 10 minutes Q&A Presenters: 2 to 3 (max 3) Format: multiple slides (optional)

Talk about projects that offer **new, innovative, and relevant** discussion of ideas, methods, technologies or techniques. Your project should offer a **different perspective** by virtue of setting, discipline, or approach.



Show a successful

knowledge or lessons learned.**



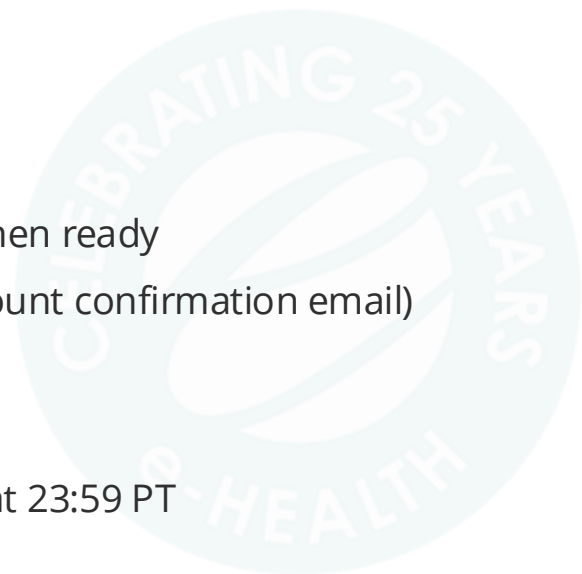
More tips

- Share your experience, findings, and result
- Clearly describe the experience and expected outcome or a new initiative with an approved strategic plan and budget
- Include a recommendation for next steps
- Demonstrate concrete outcomes of an initiative completed or in progress



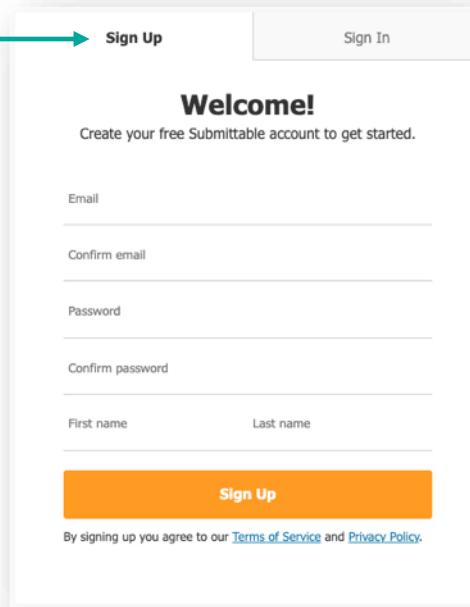

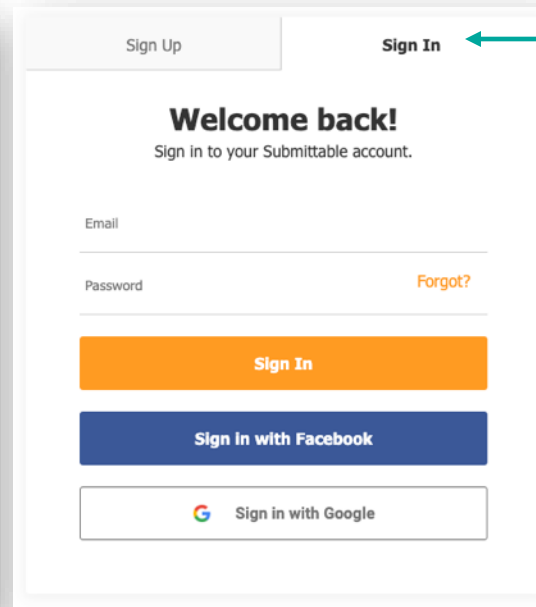
